21 Aug. 1809 Copyholders Consent to John Wells  
to inclose a piece of Waste .

" We whose names are underwritten being  
Copyhold Tenants of the Manor of Thorney Hall  
in the County of Suffolk Do as far as in us  
lies give grant and allow the Beaser hereof  
John Wells to make such additione & alteration  
to a Cottage which he have lately erected  
upon the Waste of the Lord of the said Manor  
containing by estimation between thirty and  
forty rods but not to make any further  
inclosure upon the said Waste and We do  
hereby recommend him as an honest and  
Industrious Man to the Lord of the said  
Manor. Witness our hands the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup>.
