

27 Jan. 1817 Licence to Wm. Beard to inclose  
- Granted made 22 Jan. 1820.

"Whereas William Beard of Stowupland, in the County of Suffolk Farmer having lately inclosed a piece of Land in Stowupland aforesaid and since that has erected thereon or on some part thereof a Cottage & which Cottage and Premises are now in the occupation of Joseph Berry and contain about 30 Rods and a butt upon Land belonging to John Edget Rust Esquire towards the West and bounded by Thorney Green on all other parts.. Now we whose Hands are hereunder written being Land Owner and Occupiers of Lands within the said Parish of Stowupland and Copyhold Tenants of the Manor of Thorney Hall Do hereby give our free consent that the aforesaid Cottage and premises shall stand remain and be inclosed for ever hereafter without interruption from us any or either of us Witness are Hands this 27<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1817.
